To apply for The RSF Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Plan to be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate/vocational school student in the Fall of 2023
- be a citizen of the United States of America
- be a legal resident of the state of Arkansas
- demonstrate academic potential and ability
- be classified as a high school junior for the academic year of 2021-2022
- belong to a high school in the Fort Smith or Van Buren School District
- demonstrate financial need
- meet application deadlines

Application must include the following:

- 1.) Three letters of recommendation from school faculty members (emailed to therobinsSF@gmail.com).
- 2.) Personal statement

- 3.) CV and photo (headshot)
- 4.) Official high school transcript and a progress report capturing midterm grades for the first semester of junior year (must be mailed directly from the school to The RSF mailing address)
